



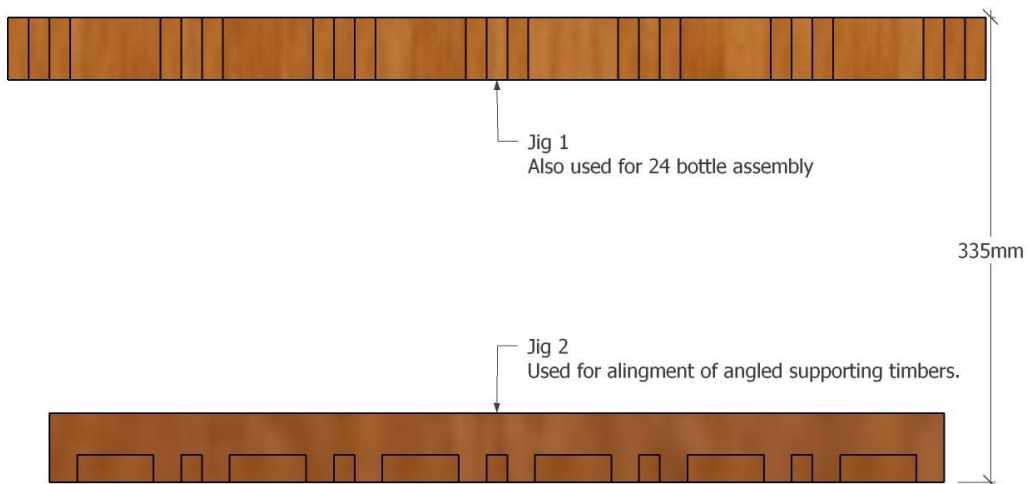
JIG INSTRUCTIONS FOR A 6 BOTTLE DISPLAY

Please note that there are 2 JIGs used for this process.

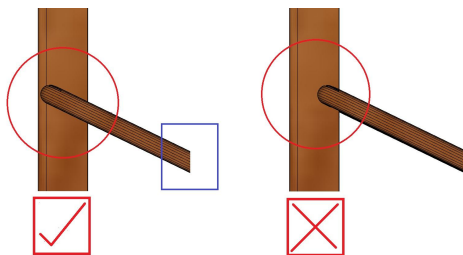
Our wine racks are easily assembled with basic hand tools.

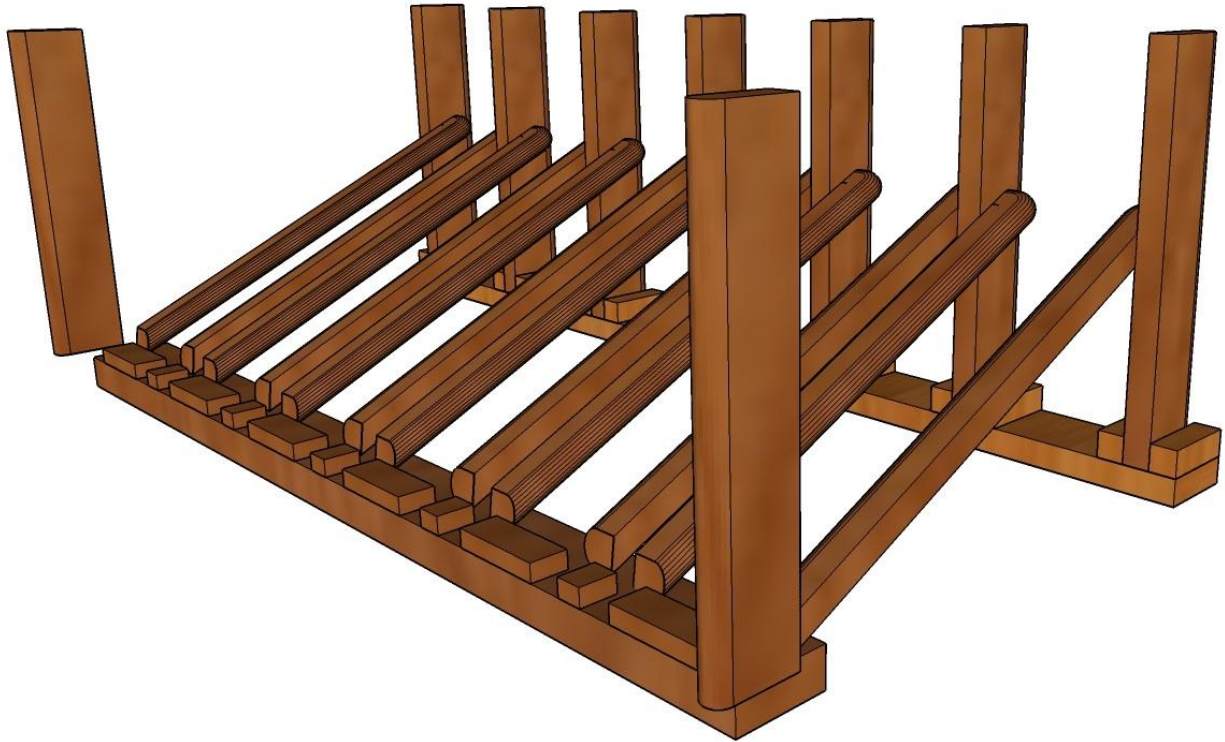
Tools required - Hand screw driver only. (wood will split with too much force from power drills)

1) Lay the 2 JIGs approximately 335mm apart as shown above.

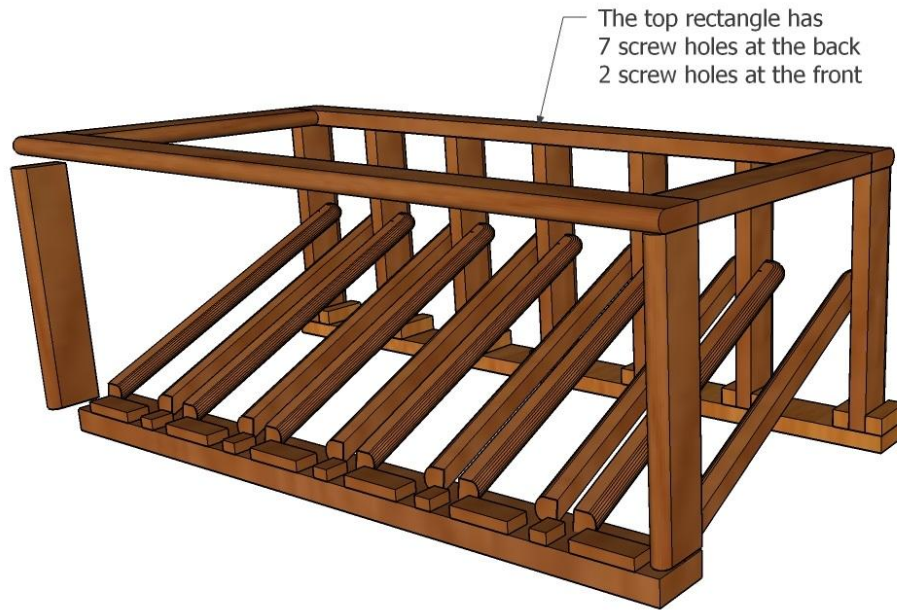


2) Place each of the wine rack Vertical units into the Jig 1, ENSURE that the finger is to the back of the vertical bar and that the cut on the finger is vertical. See image below.



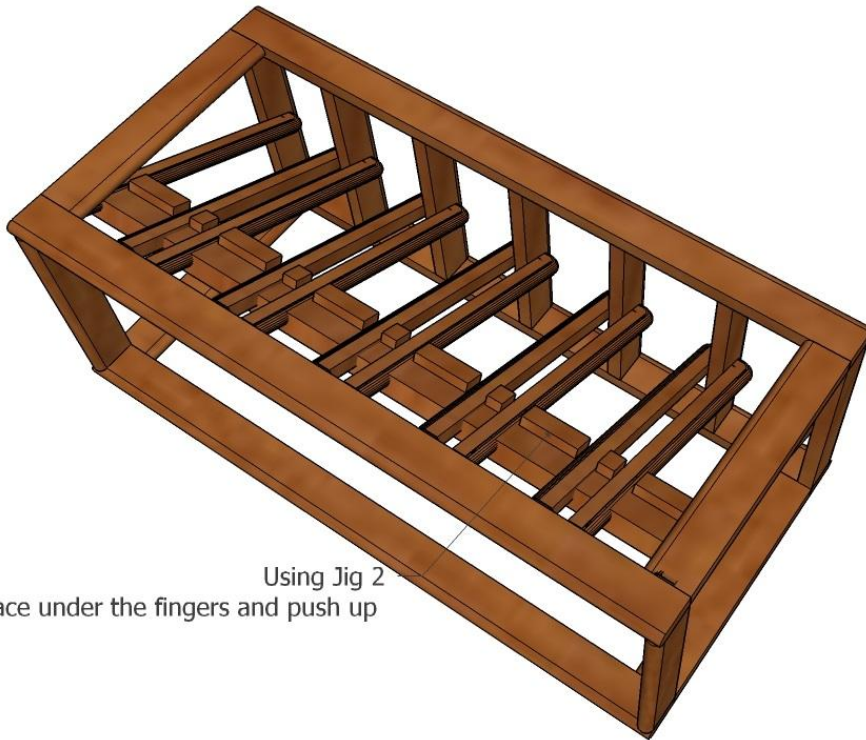


3) Place the open rectangular section on top of the Unit. The TOP rectangle has 7 screw holes at the back and 2 screw holes at the front.



4) Turn the unit upside down and remove the Jig. Screw in the bottom Rectangle into the vertical bars ONLY, 7 screws at back, 2 screws at front.

Place the Jig 2 under the angled fingers and push up. This will locate them prior to screwing the fingers in place. Screw the Fingers into place.

5) Screw in the front finishing bar to complete the 6 bottle display unit.
